Annual Leave

Generous holiday entitlement; business support staff receive 28 days annual holiday, up to 5 closure days plus 8 statutory days (pro rata for part time staff) rising to 32 days after 5 years of service.

Staff Development

The College promotes a culture of continuous professional development and offers a wide range of development opportunities to all staff.
